**Resolution No: R05-048-01**

**Weight Restrictions of Various Axled Vehicles  
on Village Roads and Highways**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 15-316 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, enacted by the people of the State of Illinois, effective July 1, 1970, provides that the local authorities with respect to highways under their jurisdiction may, by ordinance or resolution, prohibit the operation of vehicles upon any such highway or impose restriction as to the weight of vehicles to be operated upon any such highway, for a total period of not to exceed ninety (90) days in any one calendar year, whenever any said highways, by reason of deterioration, rain, snow, or other climatic conditions will be seriously damaged or destroyed unless the use of vehicles thereon is prohibited or the permissible weights thereof reduced and,

**WHEREAS**, the local authority enacting any such ordinance or resolution shall erect or cause to be erected and maintained signs designating the provision of the ordinance or resolution at each end of that portion of any highway affected thereby and the ordinance or resolution shall not be effective unless and until such signs are erected and maintained.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Board of Timberlane, Illinois, its regular meeting convened, that by reason of deterioration, rain, snow, freezing and other climactic conditions, the following highways under the control, supervision and jurisdiction of the Village of Timberlane may be damaged or destroyed if maximum weight limitations upon vehicles traveling on said highways are not established.

With respect to said road, the maximum weight permitted to be transmitted to the surface of any such highway by any vehicle shall conform to the following limitations:

<b>2 axles, single rear tires</b>	<b>7,000 lbs.</b>
<b>2 axles, dual rear tires</b>	<b>18,000 lbs.</b>
<b>3 or more axles, dual rear tires</b>	<b>30,000 lbs.</b>

That the limitations imposed herein shall commence on January 20, 2005 and shall not exceed ninety (90) days in any one calendar year, and the Village Road Committee Chairman shall post a notice of the above prohibitions and restrictions at each end of the highways and roads so restricted and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this resolution shall be enforced under the provisions set forth by the State of Illinois.

Spring Weight Restrictions  
Village of Timberlane

The following village roads and highways under the jurisdiction of the Village of Timberlane Board involve spring or temporary weight restrictions. Maximum gross load limits are as follows:

2 Axles, Single Rear Tires.....	3.5 Tons
2 Axles, Dual Rear Tires.....	9.0 Tons
3 or More Axles, Dual Rear Tires.....	15.0 Tons

1. Orth Road - From Caledonia Road East to Illinois 76
2. Squirrel Tree Lane - From Orth Road to Hyland Drive
3. Hyland Drive - From Squirrel Tree Lane to Woodchuck Drive
4. Woodchuck Drive - From Hyland Drive to Silver Fox Drive
5. Silver Fox Drive - From Woodchuck Drive to Squirrel Tree Lane
6. Dawson Lake Road - From Caledonia Road East to Illinois 76
7. Reginald Drive - From Dawson Lake Road South to end of road
8. Prairie Road - From Caledonia Road West to end of road
9. Country Meadow Way - From Prairie Road South to Country Meadow Lane
10. Prairie Meadow Way - From Caledonia Road South to Country Meadow Lane
11. Rolling Meadow Court - From Prairie Meadow Way West to end of road
12. Prairie Road - From Caledonia Road East to end of road
13. Arboretum Drive - From Prairie Road North to Dawson Lake Road
14. Arrowwood Lane - From Orth Road North to end of road
15. Wildflower Lane - From Arrowwood Lane North to end of road
