

RESOLUTION R19-171-01 – 2019 PREVAILING WAGE

To the extend and as required by “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Winnebago County area is determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of August 2018, a copy of that determination being attached hereto as Exhibit Whereas, the State of Illinois has enacted, “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being Chapter 820 ILCS 130/1-12, Illinois Compiled Statutes: and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE employed in performing construction of public works, for said VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE: and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OFFICERS OF THE VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE, CALEDONIA TOWNSHIP, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1:** “A” and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Resolution which area also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

**SECTION 2:** Nothing herein shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works of the VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

**SECTION 3:** The VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

**SECTION 4:** The VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

**SECTION 5:** The VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE shall promptly file a certified copy of this Resolution with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

**SECTION 6:** The VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE shall cause a notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area that the determination of prevailing wages has been made. Said notice shall conform substantially to the notice attached hereto. Such publication shall constitute notice that this is the determination of the VILLAGE OF TIMBERLANE and is effective.
